

Continous Non-Dual-Use Statement

In order to ensure international safety, stringent rules apply to the export, transfer, brokering and transit of dual-use items. These rules are based on Council Regulation (EC) No. 428/2009. Attached tot his regulation is a list of Dual-Use items (items on this list will hereinafter be referred to as “Dual-Use Items”), and the Council Common Position 2008/944/CFSP, pursuant to which a common military list has been published (items on this list will hereinafter be referred to as “Military Items”). Dual-Use Items and Military Items will hereinafter jointly be referred to as “Strategic Items”.
